## NOTIFICATION

### Addendum

The following communication, received on 18 April 2006, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Nepal.

---

#### Brief recap of the Original Notification:

1. The Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives, Nepal, inter alia, notified a Gazette of His Majesty's Government, Section 54, Number 33, 6 December 2004 (1 page) on 15 July 2005 as notification number G/SPS/N/NPL/1 (05-3157) to make compulsory all the imports of plant and plant products to be accompanied by Phytosanitary Certificate issued by a competent authority of the exporting country.
2. The final date for comments, fixed for 2 September 2005, was extended, upon the request of a trading partner, for one month (G/SPS/N/NPL/1/Add.1 on 15 September 2005).

#### Changes Made:

The date for entry into force of this notification is set as 1 May 2006. In effect, import of any plant or plant product to the Kingdom of Nepal should compulsorily be accompanied with a Phytosanitary Certificate issued by a competent authority of the exporting country.
